EVENT INFORMATION (ICS 213)

Auburn resident Dalayna Wallace is planning a rally in the City in support of Black Lives Matter (BLM). BLM is a pro-Black, anti-police brutality group demanding justice for Black victims who have been wrongfully killed by law enforcement. This demonstration has been announced as a family friendly event, and is scheduled to begin at 1800 hrs at the City Hall Plaza and last until about 2000 hrs. At present (06/02/20, 1400 hrs), 518 people indicated they'll attend, with another 1,000 interested. These numbers are expected to grow. Dalayna and others will speak to the crowd and then march to the Justice Center. This is planned to be a peaceful demonstration but as we've seen in other recent local events, these peaceful demonstrations have been hijacked by agitators/ANTIFA. The goal of these agitators is to create chaos and disrupt order through violent attacks on police, government interests, and commerce.

Police have swept the march route, and have found multiple piles of rocks/bricks that were staged; they have now been removed. In other protests, hostile elements threw rocks, bricks, sticks, traffic cones, Molotov cocktails, and anything else that could be thrown at police. The presence of these items indicates some are planning for this event to turn violent.

EVENT OBJECTIVES (ICS 202)

Commander's Intent: allow speaker(s) to exercise 1st Amendment free speech/expression, while simultaneously protecting people and property.

Demonstrators plan to march in the roadway from the City Hall Plaza east on Main ST through the downtown area to the Justice Center. Bicycle CDU units will escort the march to the Justice Center. Traffic units will provide traffic control at intersections and CDU and other units will ensure demonstrators are not allowed to march north (to prevent interference with Hospital/emergency operations). Demonstrators then plan to march back to City Hall.

If the peaceful demonstration escalates into lawbreaking activity, dispersal orders will be given and CDU will push crowds west/south. If needed to maintain or regain public order, VSWAT elements will be activated under the direction of Commander Betz.

Any action taken by police may escalate crowd behavior. Keeping the above objectives in mind, police should make reasonable attempts to deescalate. If an arrest becomes necessary, detective units will be available for processing/transport.

As in other area protests, it is likely some will open carry. If weapons are not displayed in a threatening manner, this is a lawful expression and police action should not be taken.

VSWAT elements should provide over-watch looking for agitators and other potential threats to public safety.

Warnings



Warning for Disorderly Conduct, Road/Sidewalk Blockade:

"Attention! This is the [agency] Police. My name is [rank and name]. You are unlawfully obstructing vehicular [or pedestrian] traffic. I am ordering you to leave this roadway [or sidewalk] immediately. [Provide the specific direction they are to take]."

Dispersal Warning:

"Attention! This is the [agency] Police. My name is [rank and name]. You are ordered to disperse immediately. You must leave this area now. Your failure to do so will result in your arrest."

Warning for Riot:

"Attention! This is the [agency] Police. My name is [rank and name]. You are ordered to lay down your weapons and disperse immediately. You must leave this area now. Your failure to do so will result in your arrest."

Warning for Illegal Protest Activity, Trespassing:

"Attention! This is the [agency] Police. My name is [rank and name]. The owner of the premises has requested your removal from this property. You must leave immediately. Remaining on the premises will result in your arrest for [charge]. Your failure to leave the premises immediately will result in your arrest."

Warning for Resisting Arrest:

"You are under arrest for [charge]. You must accompany the officers as they so direct you. Your failure to follow the officer's orders or your refusal to cooperate will result in an additional charge of resisting arrest, and will require the officer to physically remove you."
