Except as provided in Subsection b), a State department of motor vehicles and any officer, employee, or contractor thereof, shall not knowingly disclose or otherwise make available to any person or entity personal information about any individual obtained by the department in connection with a motor vehicle record. RCW 46.20.118(1) The department shall maintain a negative file. It shall contain negatives of all pictures taken by the department of licensing as authorized by this chapter. Negatives in the file shall not be available for public inspection and copying under chapter 42.56 RCW.	761

protected as confidential	Records confidential - Exception (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section the records of a person confined in jail shall be held in confidence and shall be made available only to criminal justice agencies as defined in RCW 43.43.705; or (g) Upon the written permission of the person.	
Redacted attorney work product; record was prepared for litigation	Work Product Doctrine: RCW 42.56.290 – records that are relevant to a controversy to which an agency is a party but which records would not be available to another party under the rules of pretrial discovery for causes pending in the superior courts are exempt from disclosure. <i>Dawson v.
