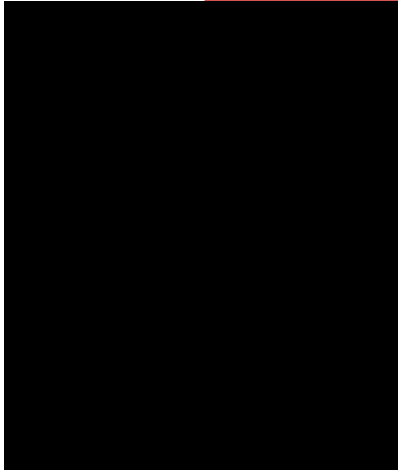

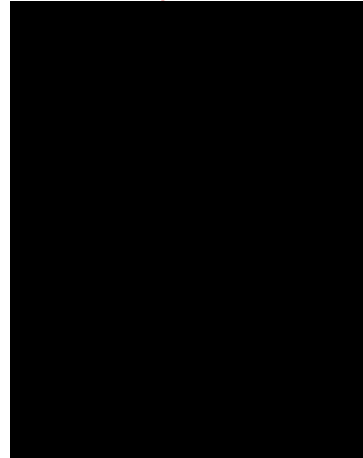

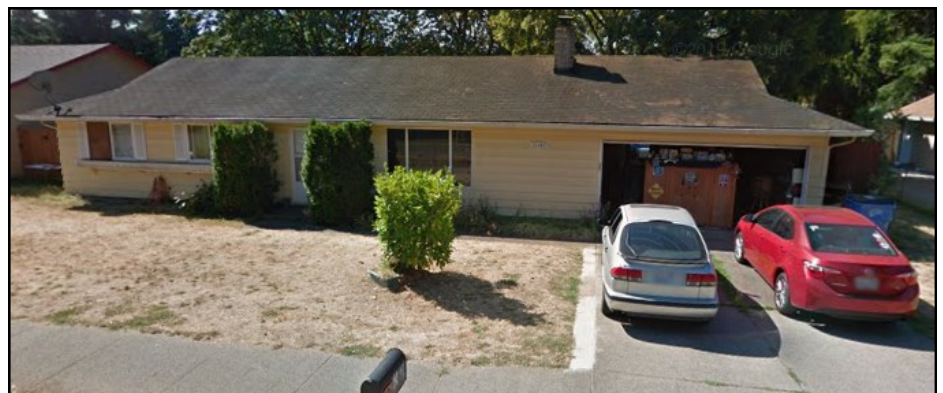

Summary: Edward Hawks, age 19, resides at 11409 NE 9th St, Vancouver, with his parents Anita and William Hawks. Edward **suffers with autism, is mostly non-verbal, and functions at a childlike level.**

He is generally police friendly, but **may become agitated by police presence or loud talking.** He has a history of violent tendencies toward others in his home, to include a recent assault of his mother which knocked her off her feet, causing a hematoma on the back of her head where her head contacted the ground (**19-5495 Agg Assault IV—DV**).

William Hawks, age 64, is reported to abuse alcohol and is verbally abusive toward Anita and Edward. When Anita attempts to protect Edward from William, Edward becomes agitated and assaultive toward Anita. **VPD Contact:** Please contact **Sgt. 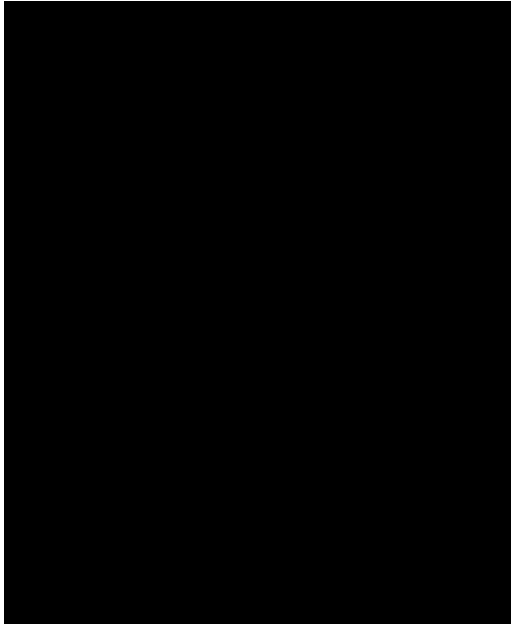

Summary: Mr. Fonseca has a history of mental health problems stemming from fetal alcohol syndrome and reportedly functions at the level of a 6-year old. He has been involved in at least six assault cases year-to-date and has reportedly made statements that he will physically harm others in order to go to jail (a place he currently claims to prefer over the 24/7 care provided to him in his own apartment). Most recently, he struck a female care provider in the face. He called 9-1-1 to report his crime, and later walked to West Precinct to be arrested (19-12556 on August 1).

Mr. Fonseca's **violent tendencies have been escalating**. While he has been happy and willing to be handcuffed and taken to jail, **please be aware of the possibility that he may escalate with law enforcement** in order to spend more time in jail.

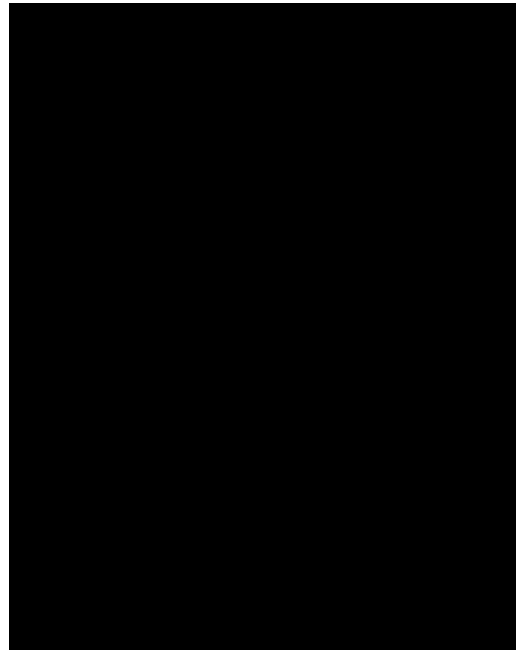

Summary:

Nelson Fields currently lives at 1001 Z St and is under 24/7 care due to a mental disability. Fields functions at a high level, but can be assaultive. Fields has been arrested multiple times for assaulting others to include custody staff, law enforcement, assigned caretakers and other clients in the facilities where he lives. Due to his mental capacity he has never been formally charged with the assaults.

On 3/7/2019, VPD responded to Fields residence regarding suicidal ideations. Fields has a history of frequently calling 911 with various unsubstantiated complaints. VPD, VFD and AMR have responded to Fields' residence nine times since February of this year.

Officers should use caution when making contact with Fields. In prior contacts with other law enforcement agencies, Fields has refused to follow orders and became aggressive when attempts were made to restrain him. Officer safety flag has been made on address listed above.

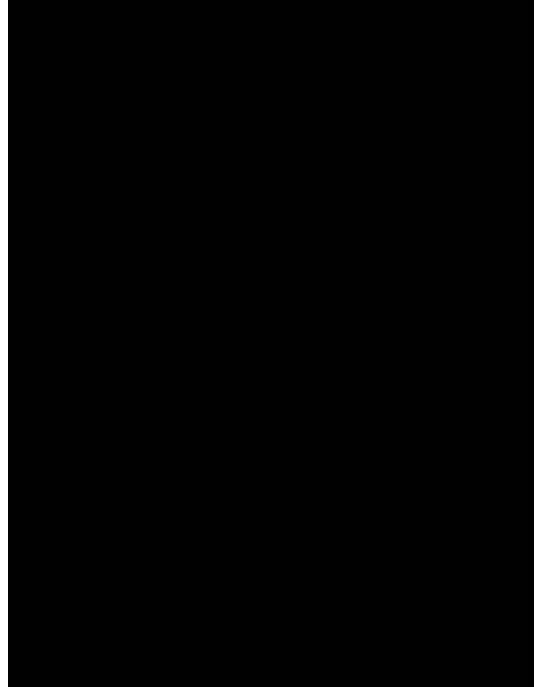

Summary:

Michael Anderson currently lives with his parents at 15022 NE 36th St, Vancouver. Anderson has a history of calling 911 in order to get attention. Since January 2019 there have been 54 calls for service at the Anderson residence. Per Anderson's parents (2319-3631) he has been diagnosed with autism, Tourette's syndrome and ADHD.

Anderson is described as being disorderly and impulsive. Previously he assaulted a CCSO deputy and attempted to disarm custody officers of their tasers and pepper spray.

His parents are known to have unsecure firearms in the residence and previously Michael exited the residence displaying two rifles. In March of 2019 Anderson made explicit threats to an AMR employee during transport.

Officers should use caution when making contact with Anderson due to possible access to firearms. Officer safety flag has been made on address listed above.
