



Clark County Jail Population Status/Booking Criteria

Population: **637** Booking Level: **E** (over 555)

Booking Criteria:

- Law Enforcement Agencies are requested to cite and release all misdemeanor offenders. Misdemeanant arrests will be booked and released by the jail or placed on a sobriety hold up to 12 hours for offenses involving intoxication. The Jail will process all misdemeanor offenders whose offenses are identified under policy 05.08.040 Booking & Early Release Exclusions list.
- No person will be booked and housed into the Jail, on an out of county misdemeanor arrest warrant, except those listed as exclusions
- Local holds will not be placed on misdemeanor warrants that are contacted outside Clark County, except those listed as exclusions
- Offenders arrested for Clark County District Court warrants will be booked and released from the Jail, except those listed as restrictions
- Jail Administration will review the number of DOC OAA offenders for potential reduction

Exclusions:

The following crimes, including warrants, attempts and conspiracies to commit them, will be excluded from booking restrictions:

- Sex Offenses, Most Serious Offenses, Serious Violent Crimes, and Violent Crimes as defined in RCW 9.94A.030.
- Misdemeanor sex offenses, e.g. Communicating with a Minor for Immoral Purposes, as defined in RCW 9.68A.090, and Indecent Exposure, as defined in RCW 9A.88.010.
- Domestic Violence crimes, as defined in RCW 10.99.
- Harassment crimes, as defined in RCW 9A.46.
- Stalking, as defined in RCW 9A.46.110. Violations of No Contact orders, as defined in RCW 10.99.
- Violations of restraining orders and protection orders restraining or excluding a person from a residence, issued pursuant to RCW chapter 26, and in violation of RCW 10.99 or RCW 26.
- Luring, as defined in RCW 9A.40.090.
- Vehicular Assault, as defined in RCW 46.61.522.
- Felony sentences which contain a deadly weapon enhancement.
- Clark County District Court Warrants, with bail listed as "No Bail", issued on or after January 01, 1997
- Any Bail Jump Crime
- Any Felony Assault crime directed towards any Corrections or Enforcement Officer
- People who are incapacitated, or who are deemed a threat to themselves, and who cannot be released to responsible third parties will be excluded from the early release and booking restriction options.
- Mandatory No-Bail DUI offenses as defined in RCW 10.31.100(16)
