My highest priority is the well-being of the officers assigned to the Patrol Operations Bureau. When I was placed in charge of the Bureau earlier this year, I began looking at replacing our current deployment model with something that provided you all with more time to recuperate between work weeks that also allowed us to deploy more effectively. While the events of this Summer put that work on hold, with concurrence from Chief Diaz, I have begun looking at an alternative patrol shift model in earnest once again. To that end, there is much work that needs to be done before implementing any significant changes to our current shifts to include, most importantly, negotiations with SPOG and SPMA.

To be clear, while the work is on-going, there is not currently a plan to implement an alternative work schedule in any of the precincts. There have not been any alternative shift hours proposed or agreed upon with either labor union or approved by the Chief. Any rumors or messaging to the contrary are incorrect and irresponsible.




