Situation:

The Seattle Police Department has been operating at an increased mobilization stage since March 2020 due to the operational needs during the current COVID-19 pandemic. During this time, the Mayor of Seattle suspended all permitted events on April 6 until further notice.

Following the in-custody death of George Floyd in Minneapolis, protests across the country began on May 26, 2020. Protests began in Seattle on Friday May 29th when several hundred protestors took to the streets in downtown which resulted in damage to businesses and assaults on officers with rocks. An emergency deployment of department resources, including off-duty was needed to control the crowd. On Saturday May 30, thousands came to downtown Seattle to participate in unpermitted protests and marches. Throughout the day and night, protestors committed violent acts and assaults, mainly targeting police officers and destroying property to include citizen and police vehicles. Seattle Mayor Durkan declared a state of Civil Emergency and issued a Mayoral Proclamation due to acts of violence, significant property destruction, arson caused by incendiary devices (Molotov cocktails) and other acts of civil unrest. In response a downtown curfew was put in place and a Civil Emergency Order for Prohibited Items was issued by the Mayor for persons possessing rocks, bottles, pipes, etc.

The Seattle Police Department initiated a mobilization of the entire police department as crowds grew to over 10,000 people with incidents of increasing violence.

There have been large demonstrations of thousands of participants on every day and it is unknown when the protest activity will end. In addition to mobilization of the entire Seattle Police Department, there have been over 1(6) personnel from outside agencies assisting SPD, including 1(6) National Guard troops.

Mission:

The mission of the Seattle Police Department is to enforce the law and preserve order. The Seattle Police response priorities are: Life Safety, Incident Stabilization, Property Conservation, and Crime Scene Preservation.

Concept of Operation:**SPOC:**

The Seattle Police Operations Center will be activated, and will be staffed with both a blue and gold shift.

DEPLOYMENT PLAN:

Assistant Chief Mahaffey is the Incident Commander.

Captain Grossman will be the Deputy Incident Commander.

Captain Allen will be the Gold Shift Operations Section Chief.

Captain Swank will be the Blue shift Operations Section Chief.

Specific assignments will be provided as determined by operational needs.

Crowd management resources will be requested and assigned, to include: Bikes, ACT, Prisoner Processing, Traffic, SWAT, ABS and mutual aid.

All SPD Sworn personnel are currently deployed under a Stage 4 Gold/Blue mobilization.

There are now various Gold Shift hours that have been adjusted based on operational needs. Refer to ICS-204 for your roll call times.

Blue Shift is 1830-0700hrs

For June 7; 1st, 2nd and 3rd Watch Patrol that are normally assigned to "B" Court Code will be given one (1) day of rest/recuperation.

COMMANDERS INTENT:

During each operational period, we will ensure that our officers remain safe and that no police facilities are compromised by any person or group of people whose intent is to damage or destroy them. We will accomplish this by ensuring that our officers have appropriate safety equipment and maintain a stand-off distance from any gathered crowd. We will deploy sufficient resources so that we are able to proactively protect police facilities and prevent any significant damage or destruction to them. We will allow unpermitted marches to occur and deploy police resources only as needed based on an assessment made by the Operations Section Chief or on-scene commander. If there is any danger to public safety risk or significant property destruction being caused, we will muster sufficient resources and formulate a plan in accordance with our incident objectives and my commanders intent.

Critical Commander Information Requirements: *Must immediately notify SPOC if any of the below actions occur.*****

-Injury to an SPD Officer requiring any medical treatment

-Significant injury to a citizen caused by police action during crowd control or crowd management actions

-Attack or attempted incursion of a police or government facility.

-FIT callout or notification related to protest management event.

-Significant and on going property damage or looting.

Logistics:

Meals will be provided.

Snacks/Water will be provided.

Transportation will be arranged through SPOC.
