Good morning,

This summer's Keep Moving Street traffic restriction on Lake Washington Boulevard was removed as planned at the end of September, but we've continued to hear requests to provide more space along the lakefront especially during holiday weekends. SDOT and Seattle Parks & Recreation will be reintroducing a temporary Keep Moving Street along part of Lake Washington Boulevard between Wednesday 11/25 and Monday 11/30.

The length of the closure will be shorter than what was in place over the summer and cover the mile of Lake Washington Boulevard S between Lake Park Dr S and 43rd Ave S, roughly between Mt. Baker Beach and Stan Sayres Park. Traffic except for emergency vehicles will be restricted 24/7, and people will be able to walk, bike and roll in the street close to home.
