SPOC has procured a number of vans that are to be assigned for precinct task force use starting Tuesday November 3.

Between 0800 and 1100 hours each precinct will need to have drivers for their vans shuttled down to Park 90/5 to pick up their assigned van(s) at the fenced Starbuck lot directly across from Training on South Walker Street.

North, West, and East Precincts are assigned two vans (one of the East vans is for a shuttle). South and Southwest Precincts each are assigned one van.

Many of these vans are rentals and only have one key, so key control is extremely important. Once the vans have been staged at your precinct, please have the key holder call SPOC at 206-684-5090 and ask for Logistics so the name and phone number of the key holder can be logged. Please update SPOC with any changes.
