DUTY TO INTERVENE *A Chief's Perspective*

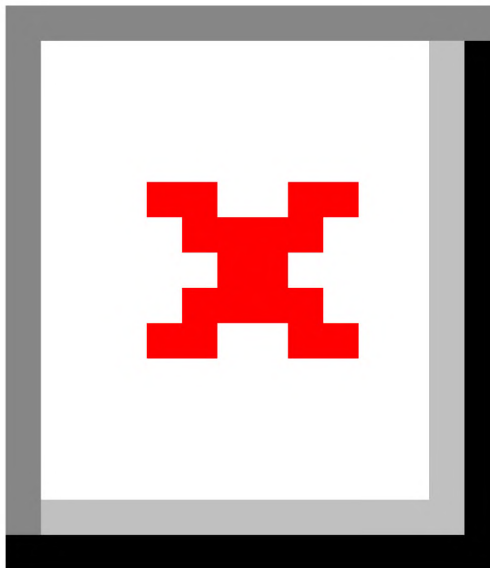

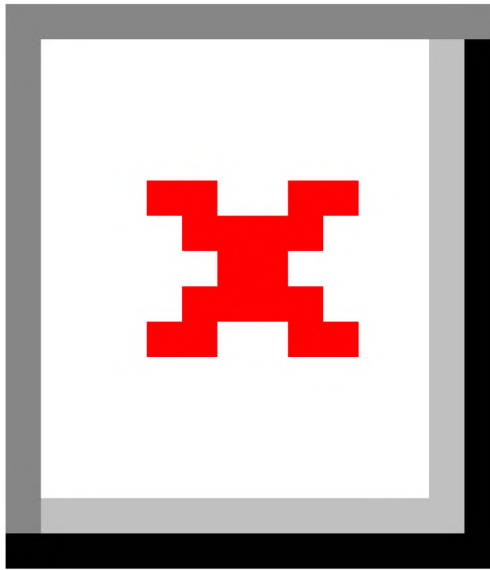
THE GRAVITY OF FORCE EVENTS

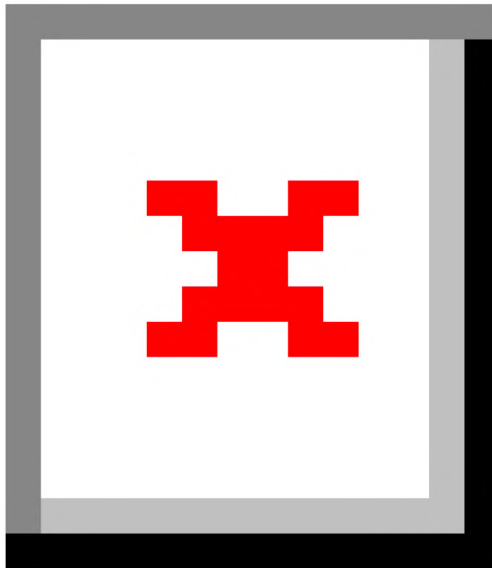


FINDING THE LEADER IN YOU

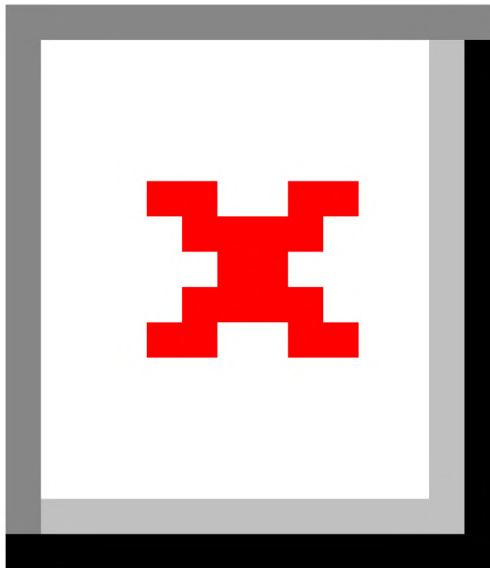
EMOTIONAL SURVIVAL FOR THE FEMALE OFFICER

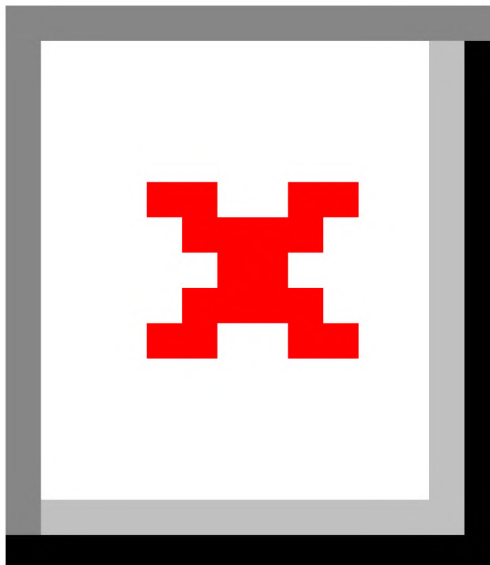
Avoiding Assault, Preventing Injury & Preempting the Need for Force

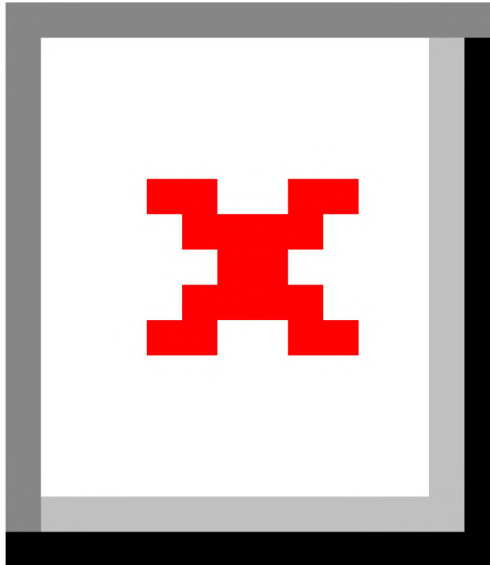


DEESCALATION, INTERVENTION & FORCE MITIGATION
